

Power of Ten

We build the daily number (date) using egg cartons and cubes. We then find the matching large Power of Ten cards to show the number (e.g. 15 – a ten and 5)

We play card games using the power of ten cards. One partner has a blue set and another a red set. The cards are stacked in a pile upside down. We take turns turning one card over at a time and saying the number showing. You can play MORE where the person who has more takes both cards, or LESS where the lower number takes the cards. If the cards showing are equal we play another round on top of them.

We have done many activities using the five and ten frame and have used this website for games on the computer
