

Enabling French in Keyboard Settings


- 1) After logging into your Chromebook, click on the **clock** in the bottom right hand corner of the screen.
- 2) Click on the settings gear icon (⚙️) at the top right of the pop-up screen.



Languages and inputs


In the settings menu,

- 1) Near the bottom left, click “Advanced”
- 2) Next, click ‘Languages and inputs’




Inputs and keyboards

- 1) On the right side of the screen, find the menu 'Inputs and keyboards'. Clicking that menu will show more options below.
- 2) Toggle the "Show input options in the shelf" switch to **ON**.
- 3) Click "+ Add input methods"



Add Language


- 1) Add the first option which is 'English (US) with international keyboard' by checking the box.
- 2) Press the add button at the bottom right of the window.



Toggle Keyboards

To allow accents to be typed, you must change the keyboard from US (English) to IN (French).

- 1) Click the circle with US or IN it to change keyboards.
- 2) Select the language





é




Le circonflexe

followed by **a, e, i, o, u**



La cédille


Press the `'` key, followed by **C**
