What is an AIP?

- An educational plan for English Language Learners (ELL & ELS);
- A working document that sets out the language and literacy goals which can reasonably be met in the current school year;
- Identification of strategies and services that will support learning goals;
- A tool that supports collaboration and shared, professional responsibility.

The development of the AIP should be *linked to assessment* and should consider the following:

- current level of proficiency in all language domains
- student's language development
- previous educational and personal experiences
- promising, research-based practices in English language learning
- activities that integrate listening, speaking, reading and writing
- authentic and meaningful contexts
- integration of language content and thematic teaching simultaneously
- developing students' language, content-area knowledge, and thinking skills
- ongoing, formative assessment that supports instruction
- differentiation of classroom instruction


Rationale for MyEd

- Aligns with the MyEd Competency Based IEPs
- Benefits of MyEd BC:
 - Security
 - AIP icon
 - Consistent
 - Accessible





Implementation

- Spring 2022:
 - familiarity & training for MyEd version of AIP
 - May/June 2022:
 - begin using MyEd as the electronic version for 2022/2023 AIPs
 - Complete AIPs for your caseload, including those students that will be transitioning in September
 - September 2022:
 - review & update (as needed) with new school staff
 - complete all new assessments & AIPs
 - All AIPs for 2022/2023 should be on MyEd
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Tips to Remember

- Only 1 active AIP each school year
 - Drafts: May to September
 - Active: September to June
- Consistent Effective & End dates needed
 - Effective date: September 29, 2022
 - End date: June 30, 2023
- Ministry requirement: AIPs reviewed at least at each reporting period (November & March)
- ELL/ELS teacher is the Case Manager (except for students with a primary Ministry designation)
- Add your own goals or use the goal bank
 - Goals can be added through District lead (and IT) at a yearly review in May.
