Sign in to Google



1 Search for **Google App** OR click the **Google Grid** to select app. You will be prompted to sign in

- Allows user to access **ALL** Google Apps with a single login
- **Does not sync** bookmarks, history, passwords and other settings on all your devices
- **Does not provide** District provided apps and extensions (Read&Write)

Logging into a Chromebook will also sync your bookmarks, history, passwords and other settings

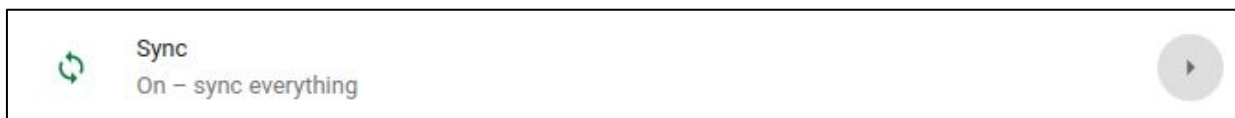
Disconnecting your account on an individual device

- Go to the Menu (top right)
- Click **Settings**
- Click **Sign Out**
- Signing out removes the local data on the device



Benefits

- Syncs your bookmarks, history, passwords and other settings on all your devices
- Allows access to District provided Extensions and Add-ons ie Read&Write
- Default setting is to "Sync Everything"
- Users can "Choose what to sync" This must be done for each device! [Learn more](#)



Concerns

- Users should avoid this on devices/profiles they do not control
- Users should be aware of what is being synced across their devices
- Users should not allow other people to use the browser when they are signed in
