



# Health and Safety 2017/2018 Anaphylaxis Awareness Mandatory Training Review

Anaphylaxis is a sudden and severe allergic reaction, which can be fatal. Anaphylaxis is a medical emergency that requires immediate emergency treatment with a single dose of epinephrine by using an Epinephrine Auto-Injector such as EpiPen or Allerject.

In an effort to ensure that all District staff who work with students are "anaphylaxis-aware" and know how to use an Epinephrine Auto-Injector, there are mandatory requirements for annual training which include viewing a video about how to administer epinephrine and reviewing two related School Board policies. You can fulfill these training requirements through a Group Training Session **OR** On-Line Training.

### Group Training Session

You can complete the review by participating in a group training session held at your school site at the start of the school year. If you complete the review in the group session **you must record your name and signature on the Group Anaphylaxis Awareness Training Review Form.**

### On-Line Training

**Or**, you can complete the review by accessing the training material on-line from the SD63 Health and Safety web-page. If you complete the review on-line, **you must complete the declaration below and return this form to the Human Resources or Health & Safety Department.**
